JUNIOR (MINOR/CHILD) PARTICIPATION DISCLAIMER

Please read this disclaimer carefully before participating in the dance event Jack & Jill O’Rama, presented by Jack & Jill O’Rama, LLC, to take place from June 4-8, 2026 at the Hyatt Regency Orange County. This disclaimer is intended to inform juniors (participants under the age of 18) and their parents/guardians about the adult focus of the event and its potential content.

1. Event Description: Jack & Jill O’Rama Dance Event strives to create an inclusive and safe environment; however, we cannot guarantee safety for a minor at our event. We are a primarily an adult-focused event and as such may include discussions, interactions, activities, and performances that are geared towards a mature audience and may not be suitable for all ages. Mature content may include but is not limited to music played, dance movements, clothing (or in the rare case a lack thereof... the 2019 speedo), profane language, jokes, etc.
2. While juniors are welcome to participate in the Event, we strongly recommend that parents/guardians carefully consider whether the event is appropriate for their child based on its

adult focus. Participation in the event by juniors is subject to the discretion and responsibility of their parents/guardians.

3. While we allow juniors to participate in our dance competitions, we strongly recommend that parents/guardians carefully consider if competitive participation will be a healthy and safe choice for their child. The competitions at Jack & Jill O’Rama are a primarily adult environment that can be at times very competitive. Additionally, in Jack & Jill style competitions competitors dance with random partners. If a minor is new to West Coast Swing Jack & Jills and planning to enter them we recommend (but do not require) starting with the Newbie division. Additionally, in the strictly division competitors sign up with a partner of their choosing which may be a more comfortable environment for minors.
4. Juniors may have their image captured and distributed by the event in video and photographs (including the livestream). Requests to have these images deleted/removed will be addressed on a case by case basis.
5. Juniors will be required to wear a unique color of wristband designated for Juniors at all times while in event spaces. Failure to do so may results in losing access to event spaces.
6. Parental/Guardian Responsibility: Jack & Jill O’Rama Dance Event requires that a parent/guardian complete the “LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE (MINOR CHILD)” form prior to the minor’s arrival at the event. In the case of a parent/guardian being unable to attend the entirety of the event with said minor, we require the parent/guardian to designate a chaperone, both of whom must complete the additional “CHAPERONE AGREEMENT FORM”. We also recommend that juniors not be permitted to participate in event activities past 2 am. However, this will not be enforced as we respect the right of a parent/guardian/chaperone to exercise their judgment in regard to the minor’s actions during the event.

By allowing your minor to participate in Jack & Jill O’Rama Dance Event, you acknowledge and accept that you are responsible for monitoring and guiding your child's involvement in the event. It is your duty to ensure that your child understands the event's adult focus.

If you have any specific concerns or questions about the event, we encourage you to reach out to the organizers for further clarification.

Please complete the LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE (MINOR CHILD) form and CHAPERONE AGREEMENT form (if applicable). Documentation **MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE EVENT** and emailed to jackandjillorama@gmail.com prior to the event.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The dance event Jack & Jill O'Rama strives to create a supportive and safe environment for people to express their creativity and passion for West Coast Swing. To better facilitate this environment, we will be partnering with Swing Reports & Restorations.

Attendees can use Swing Reports & Restorations to report safety concerns/incidents of any magnitude regarding Jack & Jill O'Rama 2026 prior to, during, or after the event. The program centers the reporter's needs and requests, prioritizes reporter anonymity and/or confidentiality, and facilitates the restoration of safety whenever possible.

- Swing Reports & Restorations is an incident response system based in Restorative and Transformational Justice practices.
- The intention of the program is to restore safety, resolve conflict and/or implement shared-space agreements whenever possible.
- This is only possible when individuals engage with the program.
- Refusing to participate in the restorative process may result in loss of access to event spaces.
- Not responding to email communications is considered refusal to engage.

Reporting Incidents: If you witness or experience any behavior that violates this code of conduct, promptly report it via Swing Reports & Restorations. We are committed to addressing any concerns or incidents in a timely and appropriate manner in an attempt to ensure the safety and well-being of all participants.

We aim to uphold the principles of S.H.I.E.L.D. developed by fellow dance event TAP, Directed by Demetre Souliotes, promoting a Safe Harbor for Inclusivity, Equality, Love, and Diversity, within the West Coast Swing Community.

To ensure a positive experience for everyone involved, we kindly ask all attendees to adhere to the following code of conduct:

- 1) **Respect and Inclusivity:** Treat all participants, including dancers, instructors, staff, and fellow attendees, with respect, courtesy, and inclusivity. Embrace diversity and refrain from any form of discrimination, harassment (including digital harassment), bullying, or systemic disruption of spaces.
- 2) **Consent and Boundaries:** Respect personal boundaries and always obtain explicit and enthusiastic consent before engaging in any physical contact, including dancing, partnering, or touching.
 - a) Be attentive to verbal and non-verbal cues that indicate someone's comfort level.
 - b) Respect and immediately honor any requests for personal space. Do NOT stalk someone
 - c) Respect a person's right to choose with whom and when they dance.
 - d) All attendees have the right to respectfully decline a dance, dance their preferred role, or discontinue a dance at any time.
- 3) **Communication:** Engage in positive and supportive conversations, fostering a welcoming atmosphere for all attendees.

- a. Please avoid criticizing or offering unsolicited feedback regarding a person's dancing or physical appearance.
- 4) Alcohol and Substance Use: Please consume responsibly and ensure that your consumption does not impair your ability to dance safely or interact respectfully with others. If there is concern regarding excessive use/impairment, an attendee has the right to refuse a dance with said person, and the event reserves the right to remove you from the competition or the event. Do not provide alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. The use of illegal substances is prohibited.
- 5) Keeping Others Safe: Be mindful of the inherent risk of injury and avoid movements that increase the danger of hurting your partner or others around you while dancing.
 - a) Avoid lifts, drops, or other dramatic weight-supported moves your partner may be unprepared for. (For example, don't suddenly throw yourself or your partner into a dip.) You never know when someone might have a pre-existing injury of limited mobility.
 - b) If anyone near you falls or is injured, please offer immediate assistance and check if they are okay. If you see that someone needs medical attention, contact a member of our staff immediately and call the hotel operator and ask for the medical first response team. In an emergency, call 911.
- 6) Compliance with Event Rules: Adhere to the rules, regulations, and guidelines set forth by the event organizers, venue, and instructors. Follow any instructions from event staff, volunteers, or security personnel to maintain a smooth and orderly event experience.

Be aware though that despite our efforts, we cannot guarantee a 100% safe and risk free environment.

While Jack & Jill O'Rama is primarily an adult-focused event, we do have juniors/minors in attendance and inappropriate interactions regarding them will not be tolerated.

You will be able to identify minors, as they will be wearing a unique color of wristband at all times in event spaces.

Inappropriate interactions include (but are not limited to):

- Offering, selling, or discussing age-restricted substances with a minor.
- Flirting, discussing, or attempting to engage in sexual behavior with a minor.
- Requesting contact information or arranging to meet with a minor without guardian consent and supervision.
- Recording video or taking photographs of minors without guardian consent.
- Initiating, implying, or otherwise suggesting any continuing or escalating interaction beyond a social dance or workshop rotation.
- Inviting minors to hotel rooms or other private spaces.

Wristbands:

- All attendees must wear their event wristband at all times while in event spaces
- There may be a charge up to the full price of an event pass if you remove and lose your wristband. This is to prevent people from passing wristbands to those who do not have a weekend pass. Giving your wristband to someone else who does not have an event pass may result in you both being permanently banned from the event.

Failure to comply with this code of conduct may result in consequences, including but not limited to a verbal warning, removal from the event without refund, and restriction from attending future events organized by the same entity. We also reserve the right to refuse admission for any reason.

By attending Jack & Jill O’Rama, you acknowledge and agree to abide by this code of conduct, promoting a positive and inclusive dance community.

MEDIA POLICY

By participating in the dance event Jack & Jill O’Rama 2026, organized by Jack & Jill O’Rama, LLC and Benjamin Morris, hereinafter referred to as the "Event," all staff members, event attendees, and participants hereby acknowledge and agree to the following media policy:

1. **Media Consent:** I grant the Event the right to use, reproduce, display, and distribute any photographs, videos, or other media content captured at the Event (including images of me), in any format or media platform, without further notification or compensation. Designated Event staff may capture media during all aspects of the event, including but not limited to contests, social dancing, and workshops.
2. **Ownership and Copyright:** I acknowledge that the Event Organizer or its designated representatives, shall retain all ownership for copyright or any other purpose, of the media content captured at the Event. I understand that I do not have any rights or claims to the media content captured by others at the Event.
3. **Consent of Minors:** If I am the parent or legal guardian of a minor participating in the Event, I hereby provide consent on behalf of the minor for the use and distribution of images of said minor, including their photographs, videos, or other media content, in accordance with this media policy.
4. **Social Media and Online Platforms:** I acknowledge and agree that any photographs, videos, or other media content taken at the Event by myself, other attendees, or staff members and posted on social media platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube, or any other online platforms, may be shared, re-posted, or used by the Event as well as any featured dancers in the media content without further notification or compensation, as outlined in this media policy.
5. **Attendees are allowed to film and/or photograph non-professional dance competitions during the Event.** For the professional level dance competitions (we will announce/clarify during the event which these are), no filming is allowed except by the event videographer(s) and those who are filming on behalf of the competitors.

Please do not film and/or photograph dancers during social dancing without first obtaining their permission.

6. **Right to Decline:** I understand that the Event Organizer may exercise discretion in the selection and use of photographs, videos, or other media content, and is under no obligation to use or distribute any specific media content captured at the Event.
7. **Privacy and Sensitivity:** The Event Organizer will make reasonable efforts to respect the privacy and sensitivity of individuals captured in the media content. However, I understand that it may not be possible to control or monitor the actions of all attendees or staff members. I release the Event Organizer and any person or entity related to the Event Organizer from any liability for the use, alteration, or dissemination of any media content that may result in unintentional harm, embarrassment, or invasion of privacy. You may request for us to remove media posted of you and we will consider the request, although we not obligated to then remove the media and may choose not to do so.
8. **Governing Law and Jurisdiction:** This media policy shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of California. Any disputes arising out of or relating to this policy shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of California.

I have read this media policy and fully understand its contents. I voluntarily agree to grant the Event and its authorized representatives the rights and permissions as stated above.

COVID-19 AND GENERAL HEALTH POLICY

At the dance event Jack & Jill O’Rama 2026 (the “Event”), we have implemented the following COVID-19 and General Health Policy.

As the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the California Department of Public Health have retired the majority of their COVID-19 prevention protocols, they have shifted from a strategy of public mandates to one of personal individual responsibility, and Jack & Jill O’Rama recommends the following:

1. Partner dancing may be a potentially high-risk activity for COVID-19 (or other infectious disease) transmission due to close physical contact. You should take this into account when deciding to attend the Event in conjunction with your personal circumstances, health, and risk tolerance.
2. While masks are no longer required, we respect and support individuals who choose to wear masks. We kindly ask attendees to be understanding and respectful of each other's choices regarding mask-wearing. Personal preferences and circumstances may vary, and we promote a supportive and inclusive environment for all.
3. If you have been in a high-risk environment, had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or are experiencing mild cold or allergy-like symptoms, we ask that you take precautions such as taking a test for COVID-19 and/or wearing a mask during the Event.

4. If you have more **SEVERE SYMPTOMS**, such as fever or have tested positive for COVID-19, **WE INSIST THAT YOU NOT ATTEND THE EVENT!** Staying home in such circumstances is crucial to protect the health and safety of fellow attendees.
5. Hygiene Practices: We encourage all attendees to practice good hygiene during the Event. This includes regular handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or using hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol regularly during dance sessions.

Please note that this policy is subject to change based on evolving circumstances and local health guidelines. We will continue to monitor local health guidelines and recommendations, and any updates or changes to the Event's health policies will be communicated through official channels, including our website, email, and social media platforms. Stay informed and check for updates regularly.

By attending the Event, you acknowledge and understand that the Event cannot guarantee a risk-free environment and that neither the Event, its producers or anyone working to implement the Event is liable for any potential exposure to COVID-19 or other illnesses.

LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE (MINOR CHILD)

THIS IS A RELEASE OF LEGAL RIGHTS — READ AND UNDERSTAND BEFORE SIGNING

I hereby certify that I am the adult parent or guardian of a minor child (the “Minor”) under the age of eighteen years, and hereby give consent to the Minor’s participation in any and all activities at the dance event Jack & Jill O’Rama (the “Event”), to take place from June 4-8, 2026 at the Hyatt Regency Orange County, produced by Jack & Jill O’Rama, LLC, directed by Benjamin Morris, and which will be implemented by persons consisting of volunteers, employees, contractors and other agents of Jack & Jill O’Rama, LLC (collectively the “Jack & Jill O’Rama Staff”) as well as outside vendors.

I understand and acknowledge that I am fully aware of and assume the risks (including but not limited to risk of any personal injury or death, or property loss/damage) to said Minor by participation in the recreational and other activities at the Event, and I understand that none of Jack & Jill O’Rama, LLC, Benjamin Morris, the Jack & Jill O’Rama Staff, our outside Vendors, have responsibility for, nor shall be obligated to pay for medical treatment and related costs if the Minor is injured or requires medical treatment at the Event, or provide reimbursement in the case of loss/damage to the Minor’s personal property.

Knowing the risks described above, I agree, personally and on behalf of the Minor, to assume all such risks and responsibilities resulting or arising from participation by the Minor in the Event, releasing the Event, Jack & Jill O’Rama, LLC, Benjamin Morris, all Jack & Jill O’Rama Staff, and outside Vendors (collectively the “Releasees”) from any and all claims, damages, or any other liability resulting from or arising out of the Minor’s participation in the Event. To the fullest extent allowed by law, I hold harmless and agree to indemnify the Event, and the Released Parties from and against any past, present or future claim, cause of action, loss,

damages, costs and expenses (including attorney fees and other related costs) or liability for injury to person or property, which said Minor(s) may incur or for which said Minor(s) may be liable, related to participation by said Minor(s) in the Event, or resulting from any cause whatsoever related to the Event, and regardless of fault.

If the Releasees incur any costs, damages, or expenses (including attorney fees or other costs or expenses) due to any injury or damage caused by the Minor(s), I agree to indemnify and hold harmless any and all such persons, by reimbursement to be paid thereto.

I understand that pursuant to California Civil Code Section 1542, a general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release and that, if known by him or her, would have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party. On behalf of myself, the above-named Minor(s), and all claiming through or under me or said Minor(s), I waive the benefits of CA Civil Code Section 1542 to the extent permissible under California law.

I am at least eighteen years of age and have carefully read and freely signed this Liability Waiver and Release Form (Minor Child). I understand and agree that no oral or written representations can or will alter the contents of this document. By signing, I acknowledge and understand that this document is written to be as broad and inclusive as legally permitted by the State of California.
